

IWC Masters Scholarships

Master of Integrated Water Management

Full-time | Part-time/distance

Every year, the International WaterCentre (IWC) offers full-tuition scholarships to a small number of excellent candidates who are accepted in the Master of Integrated Water Management (MIWM) and clearly demonstrate potential to become future water leaders.

Scholarship value

- Full-tuition (valued at AU\$ 46,200) for full-time or part-time/distance* study of the MIWM program; and
- Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) for international students.

The scholarship does not cover: travel, accommodation, field work or living costs.

* Part-time/distance study mode is available only to Australian/New Zealand citizens and Australian permanent residents.

Entry requirements

Scholarship applicants must meet the minimum entry requirements for the MIWM program:

- A completed undergraduate degree in a related field of study from an internationally-recognised institution; and
- Demonstrated English language proficiency; and
- Two years practical experience in a related field is preferred but not essential.

Important dates

- **1 May 2013:** Scholarship applications **open** for both domestic and international students
- **1 August 2013:** Scholarship applications **close** for international applicants
- **1 October 2013:** Scholarship applications **close** for domestic applicants (Australian/NZ citizens and Australian permanent residents)
- **February 2014:** Master of Integrated Water Management commences

Master of Integrated Water Management

The MIWM program takes a transdisciplinary, whole-of-water-cycle approach. It is jointly taught by internationally-acclaimed industry practitioners and academics from four leading Australian universities.

The program equips students with the integration, leadership and managerial skills to become part of an elite group of water leaders with sustainable and holistic solutions to global water challenges.

The program commences in February 2014 and can be completed in 18 months full-time or 3 years part-time/distance.
