PROJECT SUMMARY

- Critical zones for the City of Anaheim, The Linda Vista Complex is considered “the heart” of the city’s water infrastructure. This project featured the removal & replacement of 11 Vertical Turbine Booster Pumps ranging from 100 HP to 300 HP along (2) pressure zones.

- This project also included 2 hydro-pneumatic surge tanks of 10,000 and 2,500 gallons with associated piping as well as a completely new electrical CMU building with 11 VFDs sized for future expansion, 4 10-Ton AC Units, generator building upgrades, disinfection building upgrades, 5000 SF of asphalt replacement, 3 off-site air-vacuums, landscaping, and the complete demolition of 2 existing pumping plants and structures.
