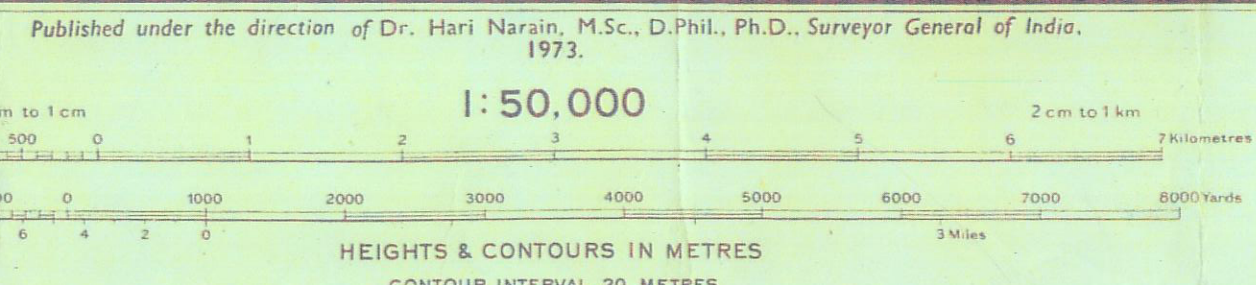

Water features are shown in blue where they generally contain water. Cultivated areas are coloured yellow. The exterior boundaries of areas of Reserved or Protected Forests are shown by green ribbands.

Contours are approximate. A relative height, e.g., 30r, represents the approximate height in metres between the top and bottom of a steep slope. Wooded areas are coloured green. Scattered trees and other vegetation are in green, but prominent surveyed trees are in black.

The triangulated heights and contours in this sheet have not been adjusted to the heights of the spirit-levelled bench-marks and may not be strictly in accordance with them. A relative height, e.g., 30r, against a well, in blue, indicates its total depth in metres. The kilometre stone numbers along the railway and roads are shown in slant type, e.g., 25 whereas milestone numbers are shown in upright type, e.g., 25.

Tanks, shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to September. Limits of cultivation are variable and dependent on rainfall.

Some metalled roads, telegraph & telephone lines and other minor details have been entered as a result of verification survey carried out during 1973.

Kunds are covered tanks which usually contain surface collection of rain-water.
