
Will be held in Kisumu, Kenya.

Abstract format

Prospective authors are encouraged to submit an abstract in English for review by the committee. The abstract should be text only (no graphics) and follow the format below;

-Title

-Introduction and objectives

Summary of the topic

-Methodology approach

-Description and discussion of the approach of study

-Analysis, results, conclusions, and recommendations

-Clear and understandable statements on which we can assess the value added by proposal abstract

The author must identify the Key areas i.e.(Water, Energy and Agriculture) in which the abstract would be presented.
