1. BACKGROUND

The Water Integrity Network (WIN) was formed in 2006 to respond to increasing concerns among water and anti-corruption stakeholders over corruption in the water sector. It combines global advocacy, regional networks and local action, to promote increased transparency and integrity, bringing together partners and members from the public and private sectors, civil society and academia, to drive change that will improve the lives of people who need it most.

On 1st January 2014 the new Water Integrity Network Association has become operational. Formally, it is a German Association (eingetragener Verein, e.V.). While the WIN Secretariat (WIN-S) has been hosted by Transparency International (TI) since its inception in 2006, it is now part of the WIN Association, WIN e.V.

The WIN e.V. Secretariat in Berlin is seeking a consultant who has expertise and experience working on the topic of water governance and integrity, as a researcher, with published articles or papers on water integrity, corruption or similar issues. The candidate should have coordination, communication, moderation and writing capabilities for an upcoming publication on the topic of water integrity.

2. OBJECTIVES

Explanation of deliverables, timelines and required methodology:

- The consultant will coordinate and contribute to the development of the flagship publication in the assigned chapters on water integrity.
- Desk study and review of literature, documents, data, case studies and information on the subject of integrity and water from partners and other sources.
- Writing sections of the sub-chapter in consultation with working group members
- Quality assurance of the content, language, style, flow, referencing in the sub-chapter according to prescribed guidelines.
- Updating literature in publication data base
- Delivering the draft version of the sub-chapter within the specified time
- Moderating discussion forum in web platform
- The overall assignment will approximately be for 20 hours spread over 6 months from contract signing date in 2014
- Additional tasks will entail the development of a separate ToR

The expected deliverables are set out below:

- Draft version of assigned chapter incorporating all working group members contribution
- Report on update of literature data base
- Moderation discussions in web forums on the publication

- Experience of moderating discussion forums
- Coordinating and communicating capabilities
- Ability to meet deadlines
