

# AMC: PRECAST CISTERNS

## LOS ANGELES METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY

### PROJECT SUMMARY

- Metro's plan for better transit at the LAX Airport includes the Airport Metro Connector Transit Station (AMC), "a make ready project". Caliagua was a subcontractor to the Joint Venture of Hensel Phelps and Herzog for the Site Work & Rail Systems Project. Our scope included procurement & installation of a precast concrete cistern system with the capacity to hold 135,000 gallons of captured storm water. Once in operation, this new station will allow riders to transfer quickly and easily between the LAX new car rental facility, (APM) Automated People Mover System, and Metro link rail network.

- Our scope also included all associated storm drainage utilities, procurement & installation of precast cisterns, perforated pipe underdrain system, engineered soldier pile shoring and wood lagging, mass excavation, earthwork, waterproofing, joint fillers, and sealants. Caliagua performed on an expedited schedule to complete the work in 3 months.
