



A little about our “Adopt-a-Community” (Phil’ Amanzi) Project:

According to the last census in 2012, there are approximately 1, 780 000 informal dwellings in South Africa. South Africa’s groundwater sources are infested with Cholera, E.coli, parasites and other harmful pathogens and many of these settlements are reliant on them for drinking water in their homes. Thousands of people, many of them young children, are dying daily from ingesting contaminated water and many more are getting sick.

Phil’ Amanzi is about corporate companies looking to make a difference in the lives of South Africans living with poor water quality in our informal settlements. Water is a most precious commodity and most of us don’t give this luxury a second thought when we open a tap for a glass of clean water in our homes.

Along with our sister company and primary sponsor, Ozone Water (www.o3water.co.za) we have designed a corporate responsibility initiative called “Adopt A Community”. This initiative aims to supply each household in these affected areas with a UF filtration device that removes up to 99.9999% of harmful bacteria, viruses and parasites from water before drinking it. This will save lives and help households remain healthy, keep kids in school rather than looking for clean water sources and take pressure off our health care systems and government. This bag and filter system requires no electricity and no special skills to use effectively.
